## Dear Hayley

I refer to the recent one year follow up review for the Use of Resources, Teaching Quality and Student Achievement and Progress domains identified during Jarrahdale Primary School's Public School Review in Term 3, 2021.

I am advised that Mr Rohan Smith, Director, Public School Review and Ms Natalie Dennis, Principal, Cervantes Primary School, met with you and members of staff, to consider the extent to which the school has made sufficient and sustainable progress against the report's recommendations for the 3 domains.

The advice received confirms that the school has met the Standard in relation to all recommendations made for these domains. As discussed with the review team, I have been advised of the following highlights and achievements of your staff under each of the domains:

## **Use of Resources**

The manager corporate services (MCS) has established herself in the role aligning processes with departmental expectations with support of the financial consultants. The working relationship between the Principal and MCS has fostered a financially skilled, compliant and efficient workplace with financial induction in place for all staff.

## **Teaching Quality**

The implementation of an Instructional Framework based on the principles of lesson design has been developed. Staff have been supported in their implementation of this through the provision of high quality professional learning, instructional coaching and timely formalised feedback on their practice. Intervention for students with knowledge gaps, where required, is being delivered by skilled teaching staff and allied education professionals.

## **Student Achievement and Progress**

Staff are able to identify, using student achievement data, the areas for improvement in lesson and program delivery. Achievement targets are set for individual students throughout the school and achievement data is regularly reported to the Board and parents/families. The school partners with the community in setting high expectations for student achievement and progress.

Jarrahdale Primary School is to be congratulated for its professional commitment by firstly, noting the areas for improvement and secondly, implementing strategies that have resulted in the improvements desired.

The next Public School Review of Jarrahdale Primary School, inclusive of all domains, is scheduled for Term 3, 2024.

I wish you and the staff continued success in your endeavours to provide high quality education at Jarrahdale Primary School.
